PARKING AND LOCATION INFO:

Tower 14 is located towards North-West end of Zuma Beach in Malibu at 30500 Pacific Coast Highway, Malibu, CA 90265 (This address can be used for online mapping software or in car navigation). Look for the BIG YELLOW SICKY DICKY TENTS on the beach. Estimated driving time from Santa Monica is 25 to 35 minutes.

You may choose to enter the Zuma Beach parking lot off of PCH near Busch Drive or you may choose to park on PCH.

If you are coming from the South and want to park on the street, you will have to make a U-turn at the Trancas Canyon Rd. stop light. Remember to park with two tires on the pavement and two on the dirt because the Sheriffs may ticket you if you don't. The street parking is not metered but is on a first come first serve basis. There should be more than enough spaces in the parking lot and or on PCH.
